May 25, 2010, the next spring meeting of the Dutch Society for Pattern Recognition and Image Processing [NVPHBV, www.nvphbv.nl] will be held in Delft in "de Berlage Zaal" at the Faculty of Architecture, Julianalaan 134, 2628 BL Delft. The meeting will take place from 1000 to 1700 [approximately]. During the day, coffee & tea breaks and a simple, "Dutch" lunch will be provided for.

The Pattern Recognition Laboratory at Delft University of Technology will host this event, which provides a platform for an informal meet & greet of old & new colleagues and gives the possibility to acquaint oneself with novel and surprising research at various research groups in the Netherlands. Prof.dr.Patrick Groenen [Erasmus School of Economics] has agreed to give an invited lecture.

Researchers interested in giving a presentation are invited to *e-mail* a proposal in the form of, roughly, a 300 word abstract in English to m.loog@tudelft.nl. Welcomed contributions are in the areas of pattern recognition and image processing, where this spring's emphasis is on [the applications of] the former field. We aim to accommodate about eight talks, but the precise setup may depend on the number and level of proposals received. The abstract's header should contain : title, author[s], full affiliation[s] and *e-mail* address of the first author.

The deadline for the submission of abstracts is April 16, 2010. Authors will be notified about acceptance within two week of the submission deadline.
